Frequently Asked Questions:

HOW TO SAVE MONEY ON TEXTBOOKS?

Queens College of Theology offers a digital library resource to our full-time enrolled students and students are always recommended to purchase used, or digital version of their textbooks which could lower the cost of textbooks.

DO I PURCHASE TEXTBOOKS FROM THE COLLEGE?

No. Queens College of Theology recommends students to purchase or rent the required textbooks from the vendor of their choice.

CAN I TAKE MORE CLASSES THAN THE RECOMMENDED SCHEDULE?

Yes. Students are able to advance as quickly as they choose, or go as slow as they'd feel comfortable with.

CAN I SAVE EVEN MORE MONEY ON COLLEGE?

Yes. If you take more classes, you will lower your total cost of attendance

WILL THE PRICES INCREASE?

Yes. The prices quoted are only good for the semester mentioned in the header. These prices are subject to change each semester. The only fee you can lock is if you prepay your tuition. You are still subject to fee increases (i.e. Registration/technology fees, dissertation reviews, etc.)

CAN I PAY BY CASH OR CHECK TO AVOID CREDIT CARD PROCESSING FEES?

No. We only accept online payment from our credit card processor Stripe, and are subject to the fees they impose on our institution.
